- Avoid fines
- Take advantage of lost item forgiveness (one per year)
- Still use your personal library card for your own checkouts

Visit any Columbus Metropolitan Library location and present photo ID with your name, current address and proof of current educator status (school ID, pay stub or district homeschool verification letter).
