

- 6. The cathedral is modeled after Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady) in Dresden, Germany – Columbus' sister city. The original cathedral, destroyed in a World War II Allied bombing campaign, reopened in 2005 after more than a decade of restoration.
- Inspiration for the 8-foot tall Bavarian-style castle came from 19th century fantasy castles throughout southern Germany that were commissioned for the eccentric "Mad King" Ludwig II.
- A waterfall that pumps nearly 600 gallons of water per hour is integrated into the castle.
- 9. Miniature trains run on 280 feet of track and more than 50 pounds of artificial snowflakes simulate 600 square feet of snow-covered land.
- 10. The historic lobby of Huntington's original bank building was the longtime home of the display. Other than during its 2015 renovation, Main Library has showcased the Huntington Holiday Train every year since 2009.

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
