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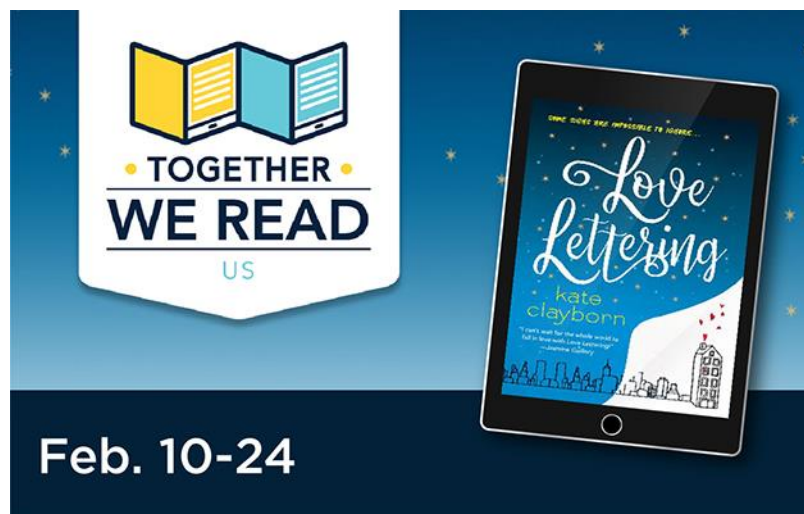
Library to participate in global eBook club

COLUMBUS—Columbus Metropolitan Library (CML) is participating in [Together We Read](#), a digital book club set on a global scale to introduce and connect as many passionate readers as possible to eBooks. The program allows owners of digital eReader devices – and holders of CML library cards – to instantly download a specific eBook or eAudiobook with no waits or holds.

Starting **Wednesday, Feb. 10** and ending **Wednesday, Feb. 24**, [Love Lettering](#) by Kate Clayborn will be the featured title.

Thousands of FREE library eBooks are waiting to be downloaded by CML customers at columbuslibrary.org.

In 2020, CML customers downloaded 2.7 million digital items – with numbers trending upward in 2021.



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Columbus Metropolitan Library has served the people of Franklin County, Ohio since 1873.
