**COLUMBUS**—As thousands of central Ohio children and teens return to school this month, Columbus Metropolitan Library's (CML) Homework Help Centers reopen at all 23 locations. Starting Wednesday, Aug. 14, K-12 students will once again have a free place to get help with their homework from friendly staff and volunteers.
