Online Resources

Search these online resources to learn more about the collection before your visit:

- 1) Online catalog includes books, magazines, periodicals and some microfilm. Some items may already be digitized and will be linked in the catalog record.
- 2) My History includes photos, documents, books and other items from the community and the library's collection.
- 3) <u>Finding aids</u> give you a listing of archives and photograph collections. Most of these items are not yet digitized.
- 4) Columbus Dispatch Digital is the searchable newspaper from 1871 to 1985.
