
Make your own Jack-o-Lantern

Materials needed:


- Paper (orange and green)
- Black crayon or other color if you choose
- Scissors
- Glue

Directions:

- 1. On the orange piece of paper let your child draw the shape of a pumpkin.
 - a. Note it does not have to be perfect, the idea is to get them using their writing grip. Whatever shape they put works.



- 2. Cut out the pumpkin
 - a. Scissor tip have child give a thumbs up, thumb goes in smaller hole, the other fingers in bigger. Make sure elbow is tucked in (no chicken wings) and open wide and snap like an alligator.











3. Draw a stem on green paper and cut it out.





- 4. Draw a face on your jack-o-lantern.
 - a. Talk with your child about what emotion the pumpkin is making.



5. Make more jack-o-lanterns and use to decorate or keep talking about

emotions.
